

Undergraduate:

- TOEFL score of 510 paper, 64 iBT, or IELTS score 6.0
- All Postsecondary transcripts
- Minimum 2.75 GPA

Graduate:

- TOEFL score of 550 paper, 80 iBT, or IELTS score 6.5
- -Bachelor's Degree awarded by an accredited university
